Nottingham Diocese – Night of Light at St Mary's Derby – As part of the Diocese and in preparation for the Eucharistic Congress in Liverpool later this year, we will be hosting 'Night of Light' events around the Diocese. The idea is a simple one, a time of adoration with music, with the doors of the Church open and people going out to invite passers-by to come in and light a candle. The event in St Mary's is on Friday 6th July with Mass at 6pm.

It is also good to have some people in the Church praying during the night.

Project Arusha Report 2018 Together with CAFOD, Project Arusha is one of the main charities supported by St Mary's and Holy Family Parishes. The Project sponsors students, who have completed their 'A' Levels, from our parishes and St Benedict School go to Tanzania and teach in schools in the Archdiocese of Arusha for three months from January to early April. Also, financial assistance is given to the schools and to some of the poorer students to help fund their school fees. Thanks to the generosity of parishioners and others, last financial year we were able to send donations totalling £39,170. The four young people who went to Arusha in January were Abbey O'Connor-Ramsey, Sophie Woodcock, Seanna McGirr and Georgina Clements. Nikketa Newton, on the Trustees, and Grace Crosby, a project alumnus, visited them for two weeks in March. Nikketa and Grace reported back that our young people were a credit to themselves, their families, parishes and school. In December 2017 Denis Homer and Katherine Farrington went to Arusha to represent the Project at the 50th Jubilee celebrations of the Oldonyosambu Seminary. We have been involved in this college for the past 14 years and it was encouraging to see the progress made there. Most of the Arusha priests who come to Derby are alumni of this Seminary. This year we are pleased to welcome Fr Paul Shirima, who arrived on the 20th June and will be with us for two months working in both of our parishes. The annual collection for Project Arusha took place last weekend at St Mary's at all Masses and raised £1269. The collection at Holy Family was held on Sunday 20th May and raised £424.05.
